

Black Social Studies / History: My Hero Fact-File

Learning objective: To research and record the life and achievements of a significant figure in Black history, identifying their contribution to society.

Choose a significant historical figure from Black history. Use your library books or trusted school resources to research their life. Fill in this fact-file to explain why they are an inspiration today. Think about the challenges they faced and the impact they made on the world.

1. Name of the person and the time period they lived in: [Write the name of the person and the years they were active or alive.] (2 marks)

2. Early Life and Background: [Describe where they were born and one interesting fact about their childhood or early interests.] (3 marks)

3. Major Achievements: [What did this person do that changed history? List their most important actions or discoveries.] (4 marks)

4. Overcoming Challenges: [What obstacles or unfair treatment did this person face, and how did they respond to them?] (3 marks)

5. Why they are remembered today: [How does this person's work still affect our lives in the UK or the world today?] (4 marks)

Extension challenge: Imagine you are Ellie the elephant. Write a short journal entry explaining why this historical figure is an important part of the 'memory of the world'. How would you tell their story to future generations?
