Learning objective: To learn about significant individuals from Black history and understand how their actions have helped shape the world we live in today.

1. Ellie remembers that we celebrate Black Social Studies / History Month to learn about heroes. Can you name one person you have learned about this month? (1 mark)

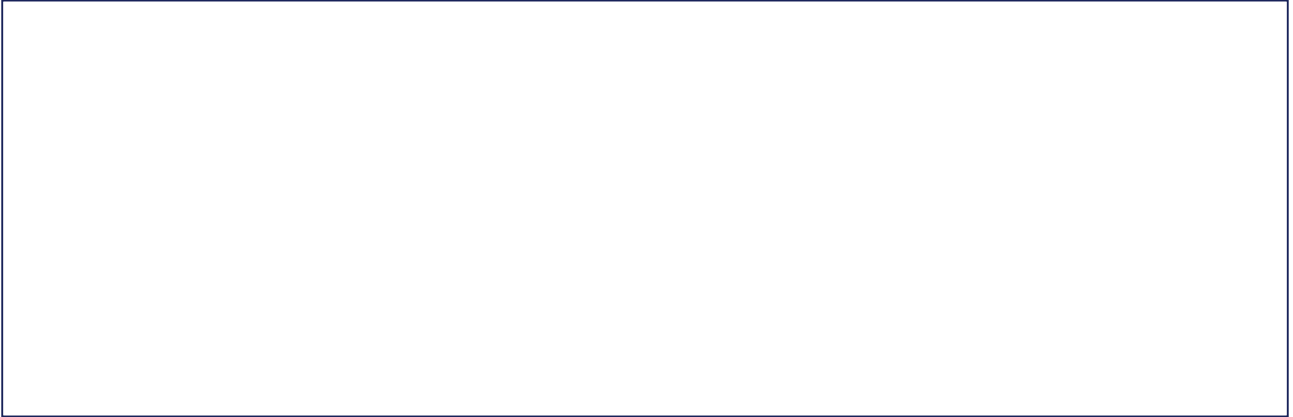
2. Why do you think it is important to be kind to everyone, just like the heroes we have talked about? (2 marks)

3. If you were a hero, what is one good thing you would do to help your friends or your community? (2 marks)

4. Circle the word that describes a person who shows bravery: Kind / Courageous / Quiet. (1 mark)

5. Ellie says history is the story of things that happened before today. If you could tell a story about someone who helped you, who would it be? (2 marks)

Draw: Draw a picture of your favourite hero. This could be someone famous from history or someone in your own family who helps you every day.
