

A Life of Courage: Civil Rights Fact-File

Learning objective: To identify and describe the contributions of a significant figure who campaigned for equality and civil rights.

1. Who is the person you are researching and what was their main goal for society? (2 marks)

2. Describe one specific event or protest they were involved in. What happened? (3 marks)

4. How did their actions impact the laws or attitudes of the time? (3 marks)

5. Why is this person's legacy still important for us to learn about today? (2 marks)
