

Florence Nightingale: The Lady with the Lamp

Learning objective: To recall key facts about the life and work of Florence Nightingale, understanding her impact on nursing and hospital hygiene during the Crimean War.

Read the information passage carefully and use it to answer the 10 questions below. Good luck, historians!

Florence Nightingale (1820–1910) was a famous British nurse. During the Crimean War, she travelled to the hospital in Scutari. She was shocked by the poor conditions; the wards were dirty, and there were few supplies. Florence worked hard to improve sanitary conditions by cleaning the wards and ensuring patients had fresh air and good food. She became known as 'The Lady with the Lamp' because she walked through the wards at night to check on the wounded soldiers. After the war, she opened the Nightingale Training School to teach others how to be professional nurses. Her dedication changed how hospitals were run forever.

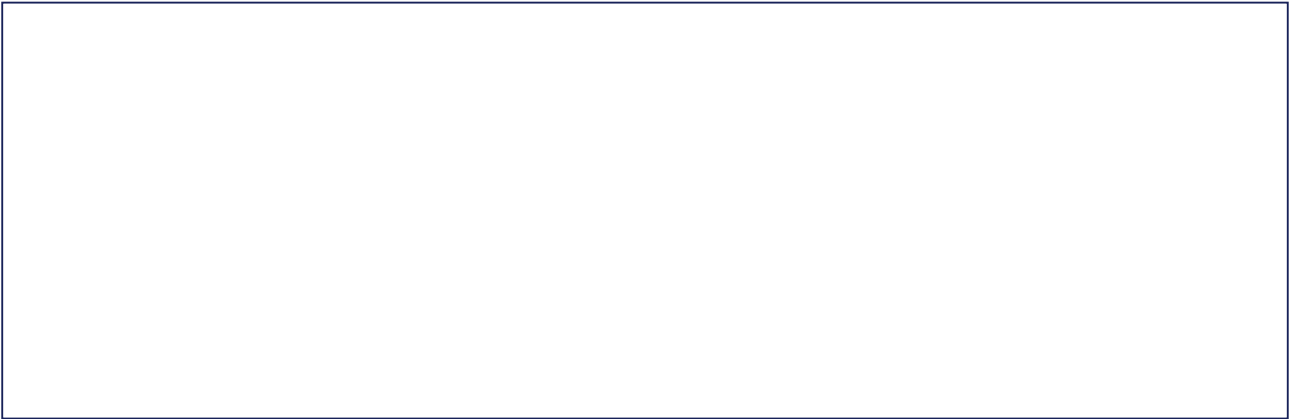
