

Max the Monkey's Addition Adventure

Learning objective: To solve simple addition problems using objects and pictures, and to find totals up to 10.

Help Max the Monkey count his fruit collection! Look at the pictures, count the items, and write the total number in the boxes.

Word bank: add · plus · total · altogether · equals · count

1. Max has 2 bananas in one hand and 1 banana in the other. How many bananas does Max have altogether? ($2 + 1 = ?$) (2 marks)

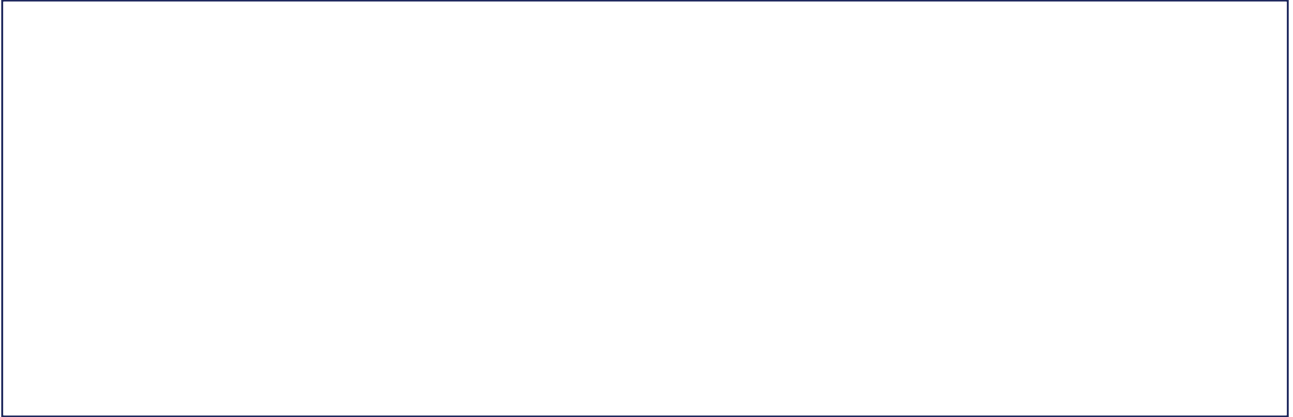
2. Max finds 3 red apples and 2 green apples. How many apples are there in total? ($3 + 2 = ?$) (2 marks)

3. Max wants to buy some treats at the market. He has £2 and his friend gives him £2 more. How many pounds does he have now? ($£2 + £2 = £?$) (2 marks)

4. Max counts 4 shiny pebbles and then finds 4 more. Draw circles to show $4 + 4$ and write the answer. (2 marks)

5. If Max has 5 mangoes and eats 0, how many mangoes are left? ($5 + 0 = ?$) (2 marks)

Draw: Draw a picture of Max the Monkey holding 3 blue balloons in one hand and 2 yellow balloons in the other. Write the number sentence underneath your drawing.



Extension challenge: Can you use your counting blocks to show $5 + 5$? Tell a partner how many you have altogether.
