

Max the Monkey's Christmas Maths Magic!

Help Max count the festive fun and solve the Christmas puzzles!

- Max has 3 shiny baubles and gets 2 more. Now he has 5 baubles altogether!
- A star costs £1. A candy cane costs £2. If you buy both, you spend £3 in total.
- Look at the presents! We can count them one by one: one, two, three, four, five.
- Can you see the triangles on the tree? Some decorations have three sides and three corners.
- Max is sorting coins. He puts the £1 coins in one pile and the 1p coins in another.

Did you know? Did you know? Christmas trees are often decorated with baubles that form repeating patterns, like red, gold, red, gold! Can you spot a pattern on our classroom tree?
