

Max's Magnificent Division Station

Master the art of sharing and make maths your superpower!

- The dividend is the total amount you are sharing out. Always place this number inside the bus stop bracket.
- The divisor is the number you are dividing by. This goes on the outside, to the left of your bracket.
- Work from left to right. See how many times the divisor fits into each digit of the dividend.
- If there is a remainder, carry it over to the next digit to the right to help you solve the next part of the sum.
- The quotient is your final answer, written neatly on top of the bus stop line.
- Always check your work! If you have a remainder, you can write it as an 'r' or as a fraction of the divisor.

Did you know? Did you know? Division is the inverse of multiplication! If you know that $4 \times 6 = 24$, you already know that $24 \div 4 = 6$. It's like a secret code waiting to be unlocked!
