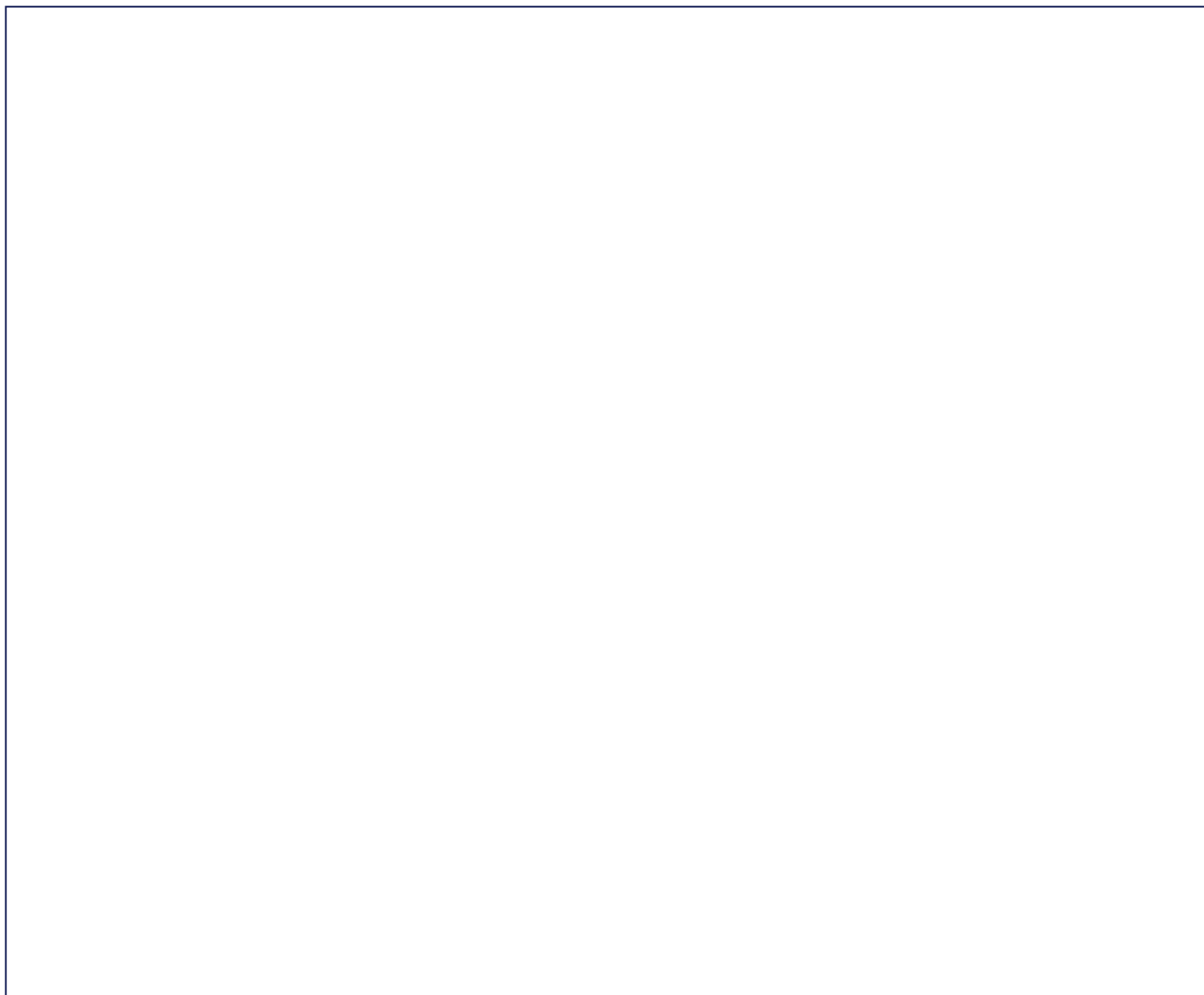


Max's Easter Egg Hunt Maths

Learning objective: To practise counting, comparing quantities, and simple addition in an Easter-themed context using British currency.

Help Max the monkey count his Easter treasures! Follow the instructions below to complete your drawing and solve the maths challenges.

Draw: Draw a large, woven Easter basket in the centre of the page. Inside the basket, draw 5 egg shapes. Around the basket, draw 4 circular £1 coins. Make sure the scene is bright and colourful. Add Max the monkey standing next to the basket looking very excited.



Label words: Easter egg · basket · £1 coin · patterns

Steps:

1. Max found 3 spotted eggs and 2 striped eggs. How many eggs does he have in total? Draw the eggs in his basket.
2. Each chocolate egg costs £1. If Max buys 4 eggs, how many £1 coins does he need? Draw the coins next to the basket.
3. Zara the zebra painted patterns on the eggs. Can you draw a zig-zag pattern on one egg and dots on another?
4. If Max eats 1 egg, how many eggs are left in the basket? (Count your total from Question 1 and subtract)

5. Draw a big, happy bow on the handle of the basket to decorate it for Easter.
