

Max the Monkey's Market Morning

Learning objective: To recognise coins and understand that money is used to pay for items in a shop.

Max the Monkey is at the fruit market! Help him buy his snacks by drawing a line from each piece of fruit to the correct coin that matches the price tag. Then, count how many coins you have used in total.

Word bank: one penny · two pence · five pence · ten pence · shop · total · coins

1. Max wants a banana that costs 1p. Can you find the '1p' coin and draw a line to the banana? (2 marks)

2. The apple costs 2p. How many 1p coins do you need to make 2p? (2 marks)

3. Max has a 5p coin. Can he buy a grape that costs 5p? (2 marks)

4. If Max buys a 1p banana and a 2p apple, how much money does he spend altogether? (2 marks)

5. Look at a 10p coin. Is it bigger or smaller than a 1p coin? (2 marks)

Draw: Draw a picture of Max the Monkey standing in front of a market stall with a basket full of fruit and his favourite shiny coins.



Extension challenge: Ask an adult to help you look at some real coins. Can you spot the numbers on them? Try to make a 'rubbing' of the coins by placing a piece of paper over them and shading gently with a crayon.
