

Max the Monkey's Market Shop

Learning objective: To recognise coins and understand the value of items using pounds (£) and pence (p).

Max the Monkey is setting up a shop! Look at the items you want to buy, draw them in the boxes, and write down how much they cost using the price tags. Ask a grown-up to help you count the coins you need to pay for your shopping.

Word bank: pound · penny · coin · shop · price · buy · spend · total

1. My Favourite Shop Item: Draw your item and write the price here. (2 marks)

2. Which coins would you use to pay for your item? Draw the coins in this box. (2 marks)

3. If I have £1 and my item costs 50p, how much change would I get back? (2 marks)

4. If you bought two items for 10p each, what is the total cost? (2 marks)

5. Max says: 'I want to save my money in my piggy bank.' Why is it a good idea to save money? (2 marks)

Extension challenge: Can you go on a 'coin hunt' at home with a grown-up? Find a 1p, 2p, 5p, 10p, 20p, 50p, £1, and £2 coin. Sort them from the smallest value to the largest value.
