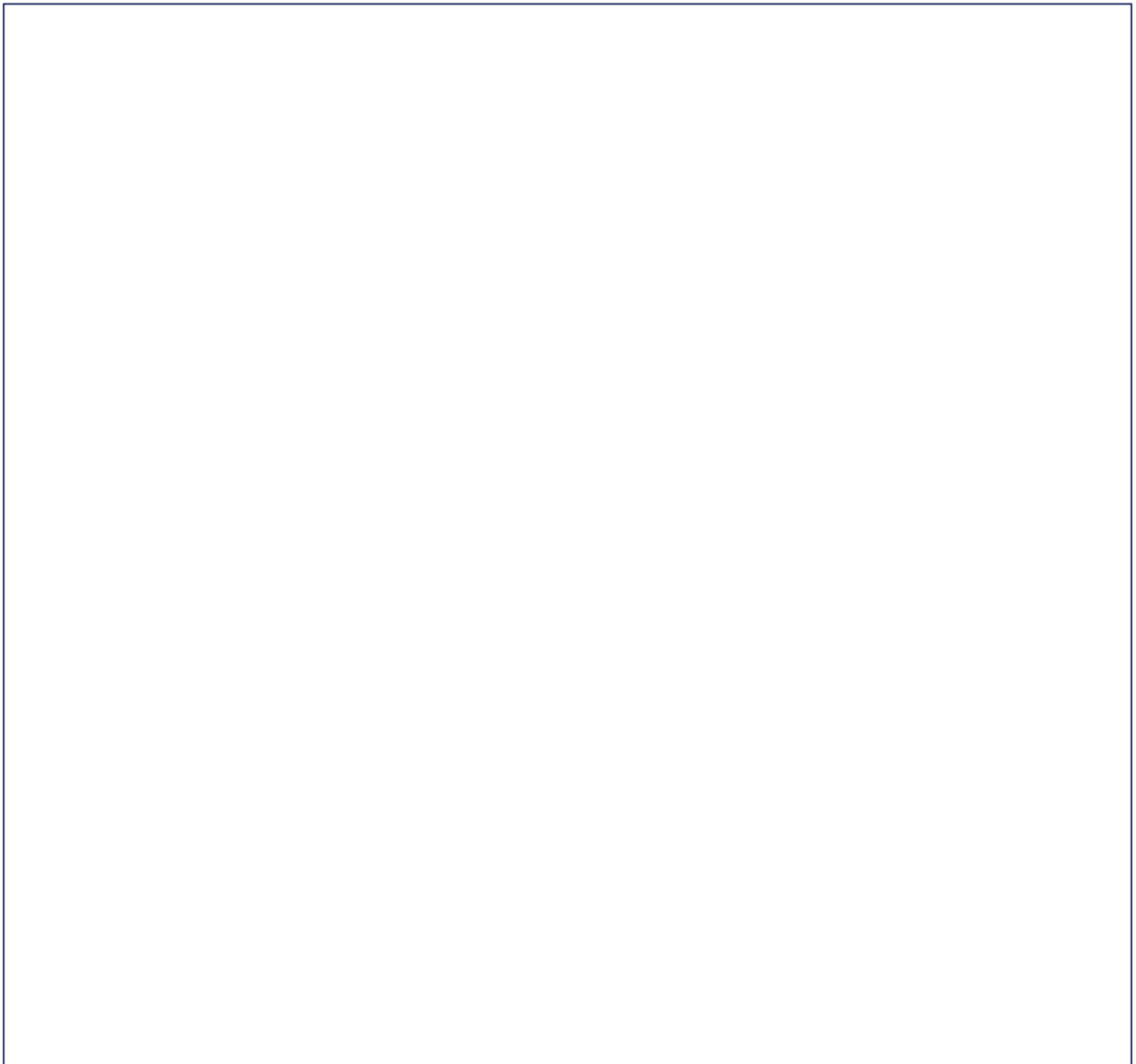


Max the Monkey's Market Maths

Learning objective: To understand that numbers are made up of tens and ones, using Max the Monkey to explore place value.

Help Max the Monkey count his fruit! Look at the baskets of 10 apples and the single apples. Colour the baskets and the fruit, then count how many tens and ones there are in total.

Colour this: A large, friendly monkey named Max wearing a small waistcoat, standing behind a wooden market stall. On the stall, draw two large woven baskets. Inside each basket, draw 10 small, clear circles representing apples. Outside the baskets, draw 3 individual apples. Beside the stall, draw a sign with a price tag that says '£1 each'. Max should have a happy expression. Use thick, bold outlines suitable for colouring.



Steps:

1. How many baskets of 10 apples can you see in the picture?
2. How many single apples (the ones) are sitting outside the baskets?
3. If Max finds 1 more single apple, how many apples will he have altogether?
