

Max the Monkey's Number Garden

Learning objective: To understand that teen numbers are made of a group of ten and some extra ones.

Max the Monkey has been collecting items in his garden. Help him count the groups of ten and the extra ones to find the total.

Max the Monkey is sorting his fruit. He has one full bag of ten bananas and some extra bananas outside the bag. Help Max count them up!

Word bank: ten · ones · total · group · number

1. Max has 1 bag of ten apples and 3 apples outside. How many apples does he have in total? Write the number. (2 marks)

2. If Max has 10 acorns in a box and 5 acorns on the ground, how many acorns are there altogether? (2 marks)

3. Max has 12 coins. Can you circle the '1' to show there is one group of ten? (1 mark)

4. Look at the number 14. Which digit shows the group of ten? (1 mark)

5. Max finds 10 berries and 7 more. Draw a line to the correct total: 15 or 17? (2 marks)

Draw: Draw a bag with 10 circles inside to show a 'group of ten', and draw 4 more circles outside the bag to make the number 14.



Extension challenge: Max wants to buy a toy for £15. If he has one £10 note and some £1 coins, how many £1 coins does he need to make £15?
