Learning objective: To practise rounding any number up to 1,000,000 to the nearest 10, 100, 1,000, 10,000 and 100,000.

Use these flashcards to help you master rounding. Max the monkey thinks rounding is a clever way to estimate quickly! Look at the front, try to solve the rounding puzzle, then check your answer on the back.

Round 4,321 to the nearest 10.

Round 7,856 to the nearest 100.

Round 12,499 to the nearest 1,000.

Max bought a banana bunch for £4.56. Round this price to the nearest pound (£).
