

Max's Shape Scavenger Hunt

Learning objective: To identify and name common 2D shapes (circle, square, triangle, rectangle) in the environment.

Max the monkey is exploring the park and he has found lots of shapes! Look at the objects listed below. Decide which 2D shape each object is most like. Draw a line to match the object to the correct shape name in the word bank.

Word bank: Circle · Square · Triangle · Rectangle

1. A slice of cheesy pizza has three sides. Which shape is it? (1 mark)

2. A shiny gold coin is perfectly round. Which shape is it? (1 mark)

3. A window has four equal sides. Which shape is it? (1 mark)

4. A long chocolate bar wrapper has two long sides and two short sides. Which shape is it? (1 mark)

5. If you draw a shape with four corners, how many sides does it have? (2 marks)

Draw: Draw a picture of a house using only circles, squares, triangles, and rectangles. _____
Label the shapes you have used.



Extension challenge: Go on a shape hunt around your classroom or home. Can you find something that is a circle and something that is a rectangle? Tell a partner why you think they are those shapes.
