- A composer is a creative architect of sound who translates their ideas into a written document called a score.
- Musical notation acts as a universal language, allowing musicians from all over the world to interpret the composer's original intentions.
- Dynamics provide the 'colour' of a piece, telling performers whether to play with a whisper-soft 'piano' volume or a thunderous 'forte'.
- The tempo dictates the speed of the music, which can change the entire mood from a calm, flowing river to a frantic, bustling city street.
- Composers often draw inspiration from the natural world, stories, or historical events to craft their melodies.

Did you know? Did you know? Before computers existed, composers wrote every single note by hand using a quill or pen! They had to be incredibly neat, because if a smudge covered a note, the whole orchestra might play the wrong sound during a performance.
