

Max's Striking and Fielding Match Report

Learning objective: To identify and describe the key skills and tactics used in striking and fielding games.

Max the monkey loves to turn every game into a puzzle! Use this report to record your performance in today's PE lesson. Think about how you used your skills to help your team score runs or get the opposition out. Use the word bank to help you describe your actions.

Word bank: accuracy · fielding · striking · communication · tactics · coordination · teamwork · positioning · batting · catching

1. Striking Skills: Describe one technique you used when striking the ball (e.g., how you held the bat or where you looked). (2 marks)

2. Fielding Tactics: How did you position yourself in the field to make sure you could stop the ball or catch it? (2 marks)

3. Teamwork: Explain how you communicated with your teammates during the game to make a play or plan your next move. (2 marks)

4. Problem Solving: If your team was struggling to get the opposition out, what change could you make to your fielding layout? (3 marks)

5. Self-Reflection: What is one specific skill you would like to improve on for our next lesson, and how will you practise it? (2 marks)

Extension challenge: Draw a diagram of the field showing where you stood when you were fielding. Use an 'X' to mark your position and arrows to show where you would move if the ball was hit to a different area.
