

My Wonderful World Fact-File

Learning objective: To explore and reflect on creation stories from different cultures, identifying the key elements of the natural world.

Today, we are learning about creation stories. Many cultures believe the world began in special ways. Use this fact-file to write about a story you have heard today. Think about how the world was made, what was created first, and how it looks now. You can draw your favourite part of the story in the box at the bottom.

1. Name of the story: Write the name of the creation story we listened to today. (2 marks)

2. The Beginning: How did the story say the world started? (2 marks)

3. The Best Part: What was the most exciting thing created in this story? (2 marks)

4. My World: If you could create one thing to make the world a better place, what would it be? (2 marks)

5. Kindness: How can we look after the world that has been created for us? (2 marks)

Extension challenge: Ask Pip the bookworm to help you find another book about the world. Draw a picture of the sun, the moon, or your favourite animal to show what you love about our world.
