

My Easter Celebration Fact-File

Learning objective: To identify and describe key features of the festival of Easter, relating them to personal experiences and traditions.

Help your child fill out this fact-file to explore how we celebrate Easter. Encourage them to draw pictures of their favourite traditions and write a few words about why they enjoy this special time. You can scribe for them if they are still developing their writing skills.

Word bank: Spring · new life · celebrate · tradition · eggs · family · flowers · chicks

1. The Spring Season: Describe what the world looks like outside during Easter time. What signs of new life can you see?

2. My Special Traditions: What is one thing your family does to celebrate Easter? Do you have a favourite activity?

3. Sharing and Giving: If you were buying a small treat for a friend, how much would you spend and what would you choose? (e.g., £1 for a chocolate treat)

4. The Story of Easter: Ellie the Elephant loves stories! What is one story or legend you have heard about Easter?

5. My Easter Wish: If you could send a kind message to a friend for the holiday, what would you say to them?

Extension challenge: Ask your child to find three different patterns in nature (like stripes on a bee or spots on an egg) and draw them, just like Zara the Zebra would!
