3. 3. Why do Muslims use a soft mat when they pray? (2 marks)

4. 4. The Qibla is a special mark on the wall. Which direction does it show people to face while praying? (1 mark)

5. 5. Can you name one thing that you see in your own home that helps you feel calm, just like the things in the mosque? (1 mark)

Draw: Draw a beautiful pattern on a prayer mat. Use your favourite colours and think about the patterns Zara the Zebra might notice!
