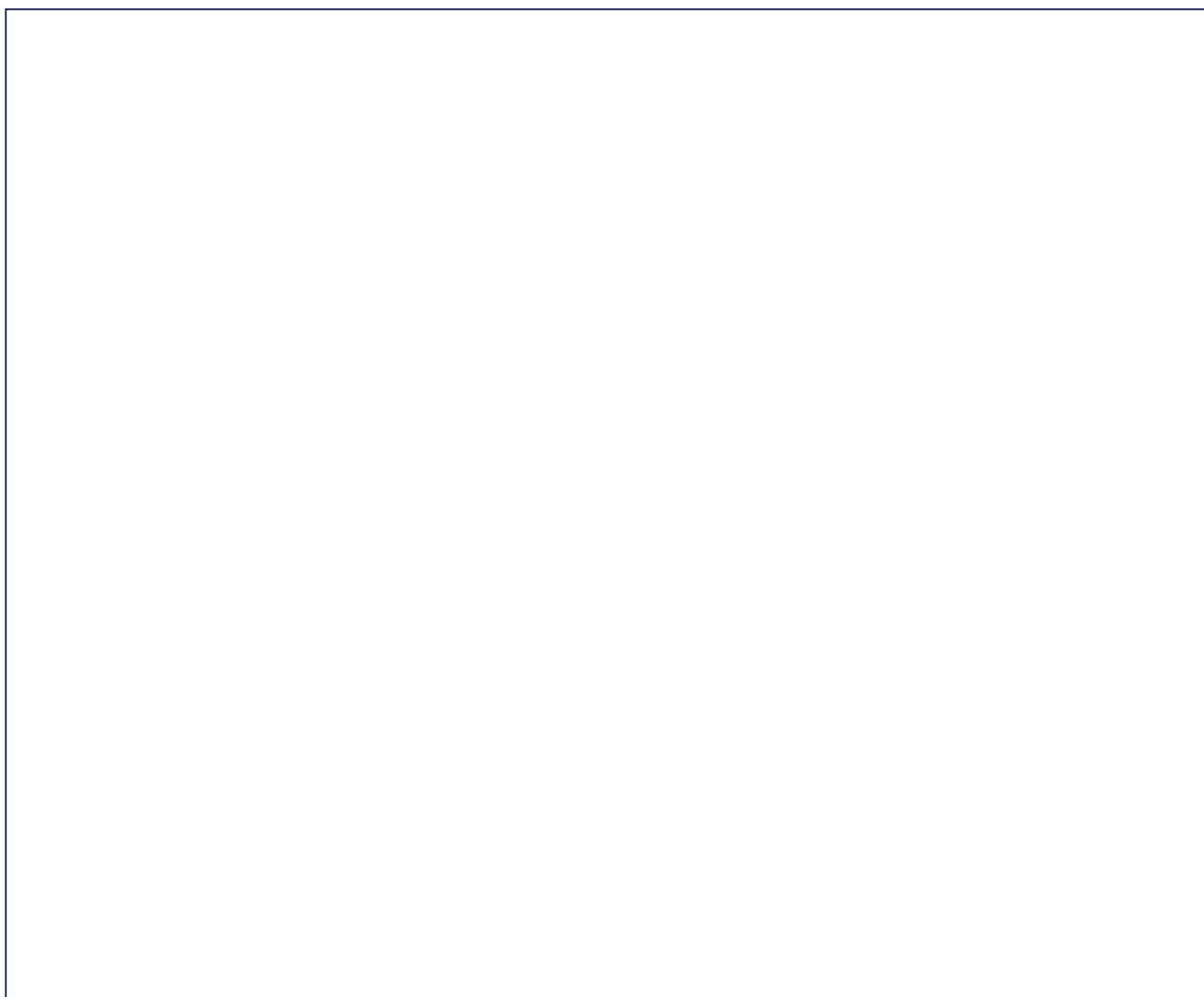


Making Kind Choices with Leo the Lion

Learning objective: To understand the importance of kindness and making good moral choices in our daily lives.

Look at the scene below. Think about how Leo the Lion can be a good friend. Draw what happens next to show kindness, then answer the questions to share your thoughts.

Draw: Draw a large, friendly Lion named Leo standing next to a friend who has dropped a basket of apples. Ensure the style is simple, warm, and inviting with bright, cheerful colours. Leave a large empty space for the child to draw Leo reaching out to help pick up the apples. Include a small, sunny meadow background with flowers.



Label words: Kind · Help · Share · Friend · Care

Steps:

1. Draw Leo helping his friend in the space provided. What is the kindest thing Leo can do?
2. How do you think Leo's friend feels when Leo helps? Write or draw a happy face.
3. If Leo found a shiny coin worth £1 on the ground, what should he do with it? Tick the kindest choice: Keep it / Find the owner.
4. Can you draw yourself doing something kind for a friend?
5. Why is it important to share our toys with others?
