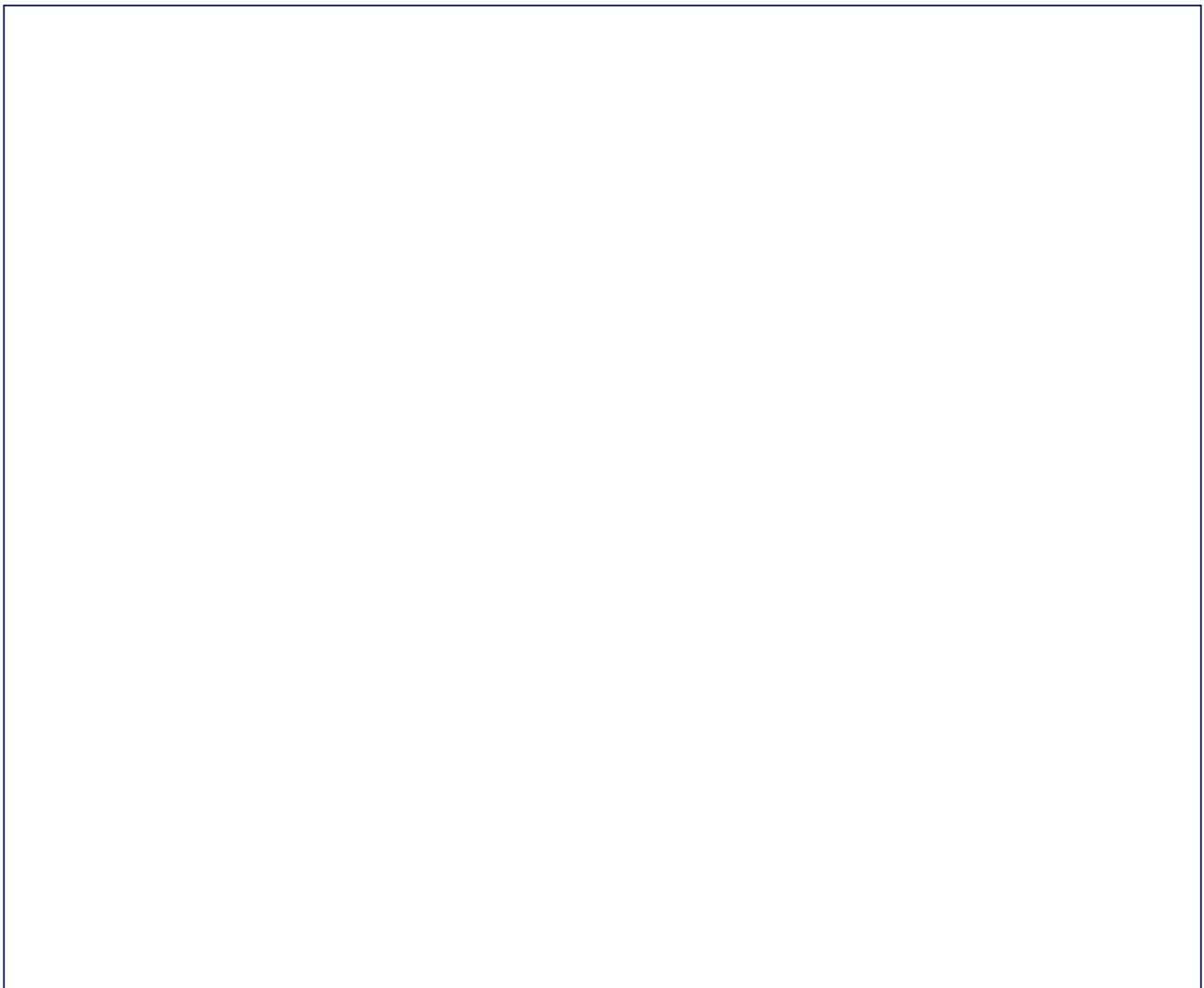


Remembrance Day: A Tribute of Peace

Learning objective: To understand the symbolism of Remembrance Day and create a thoughtful, respectful illustration that reflects the significance of the poppy.

Use your pencils, felt tips, or pastels to create a meaningful scene. Remember that your drawing should be respectful and reflective. Use the word bank to add labels to your artwork to explain the significance of your choices.

Draw: Create a respectful illustration featuring a single, vibrant red poppy. You may use a 'close-up' style to focus on the textures of the petals, or a wider landscape style showing a field of poppies under a soft, peaceful sky. Use warm, respectful colours. Include space for the labels from the word bank around the edges of your drawing.



Label words: Poppy · Remembrance · Sacrifice · Peace · Reflection · Gratitude · Centenary

Steps:

1. Step 1: Draw a large, clear poppy as the central focus of your page. Why did you choose to place it in the centre?
2. Label the parts of your drawing using at least three words from the word bank to show the meaning behind your artwork.
3. Step 2: Add a background that represents peace. Describe what you have chosen to draw (e.g., a calm

sky, a field, or a silhouette) and why.

4. If you were to dedicate your drawing to someone, who would it be and what message of gratitude would you write on the back?

5. Why is it important for us to hold a two-minute silence on Remembrance Day?
