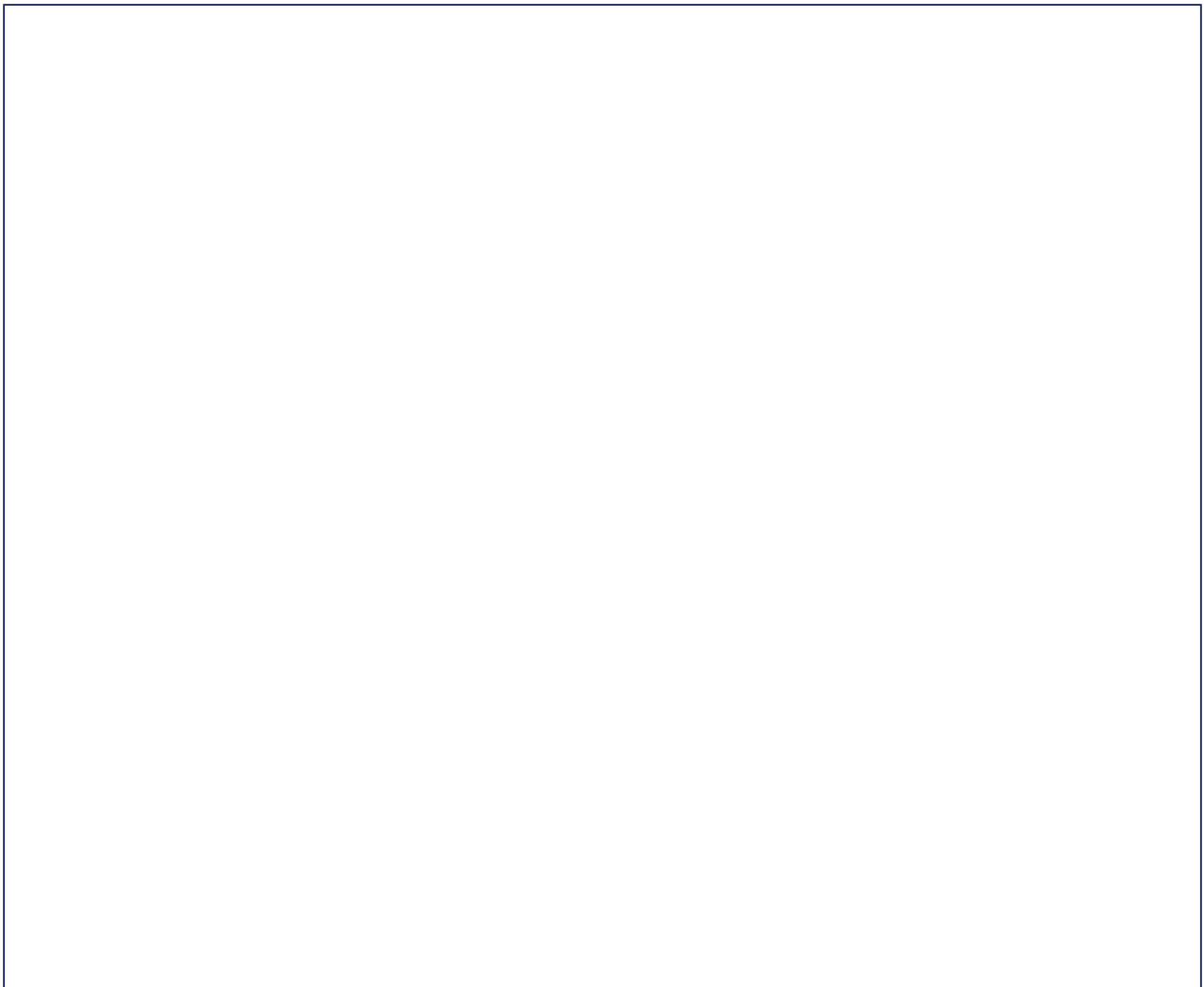


My Special Storybook Drawing Activity

Learning objective: To recognise that different religions have sacred books that are special to believers.

Today, we are learning about sacred books. These are books that people treat with great care and respect because they contain important stories and teachings. Look at the word bank below and add these labels to your drawing.

Draw: Draw a large, thick book in the centre of the page. The book should be open or closed, decorated with colourful patterns, stars, or shapes to show it is very special. Around the book, draw a scene showing a quiet, respectful place, such as a soft cushion or a tidy shelf. Use bright colours and gentle lines. Include a small drawing of a person sitting nearby, looking at the book with a happy and curious expression.



Label words: Special Book · Beautiful Cover · Kind Words · Care

Steps:

1. Step 1: Draw a large, rectangular book in the middle of your page. Make the cover look beautiful by drawing patterns or a bright colour. Why do you think people keep these books in a special place?
2. Step 2: Draw yourself or a friend holding the book very gently with two hands. How should we hold a book to show we are being careful with it?
3. Step 3: Add a heart shape next to your book to show that the stories inside are full of love and kindness.

Can you name one way you show kindness to others?

4. Step 4: Use the words from your word bank to label your drawing.

5. Step 5: Write the name of a favourite story you like to hear at home or at school.
