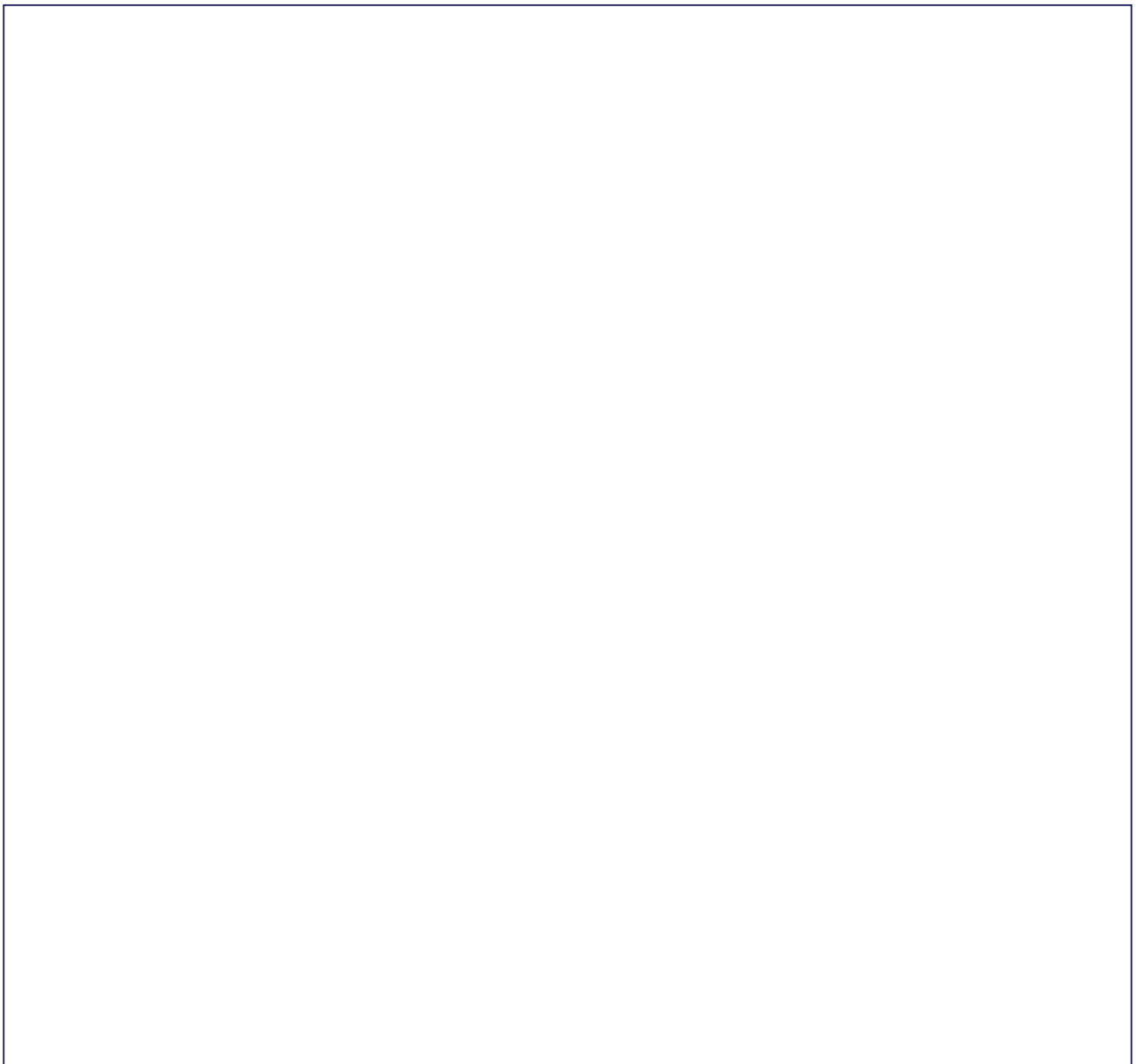


Nova's Autumn Adventure

Learning objective: To observe and identify the seasonal changes associated with Autumn.

Look at the picture of Nova the owl in the woodland. Use your favourite autumn colours like red, orange, and gold to colour the leaves. Once you have finished, label the parts of the tree and the woodland floor.

Colour this: A large, friendly-looking barn owl named Nova perched on a sturdy tree branch in a woodland setting. The tree has a thick, textured trunk and some branches are bare while others have large, crinkly leaves attached. On the ground below the tree, there is a pile of scattered, different-shaped autumn leaves, a small round acorn, and a tiny mushroom. Nova has large, inquisitive eyes and soft feathers. The lines should be bold, clear, and easy for young children to colour within.



Steps:

1. Label the leaf that has fallen to the ground.
2. Label the trunk of the tree.
