

Rosa's Animal Adventure: ¡Vamos a los Animales!

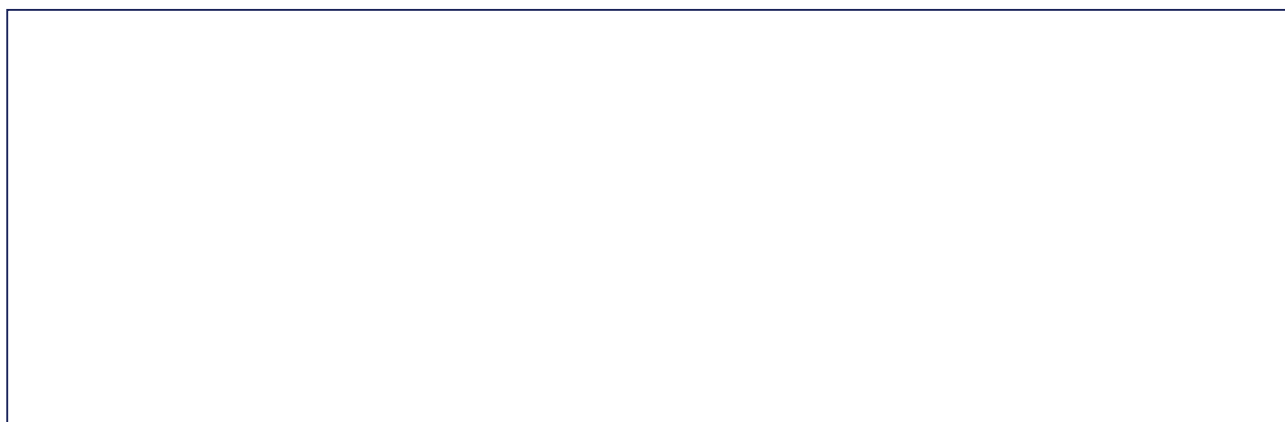
Learning objective: To identify and use common animal vocabulary in Spanish and apply them to simple sentence structures.

Rosa the parrot wants to help you learn your Spanish animal names! Look at the 'Word Bank' below. Your task is to complete the sentences by choosing the correct animal name in Spanish. Then, write a short sentence describing one of the animals using the provided colour adjectives: 'rojo' (red), 'azul' (blue), or 'verde' (green).
