

Rosa's Spanish Body Part Challenge

Learning objective: To identify and spell common body parts in Spanish and use them in simple sentences.

Help Rosa the parrot learn her body parts! Use the word bank to label the parts of the body and answer the questions below.

Word bank: la cabeza (head) · los ojos (eyes) · la nariz (nose) · la boca (mouth) · las orejas (ears) · los brazos (arms) · las manos (hands) · las piernas (legs) · los pies (feet)

1. Rosa is looking in the mirror. Write the Spanish word for the part of the body she uses to see (eyes) and the part she uses to smell (nose). (2 marks)

2. If you were hopping like a frog, which two body parts would you use the most? Write your answer in Spanish. (2 marks)

3. Translate this sentence into English: 'Tengo dos manos y dos pies.' (2 marks)

4. Rosa has a small beak. If you were to describe a human, which word from the bank would you use for the part of the face that contains teeth? (1 mark)

5. Fill in the blank: 'Tengo una nariz y dos _____. ' (Use the word bank to find the correct plural word for ears). (1 mark)

Draw: Draw a funny monster and label at least four of its body parts using the Spanish words from the word bank. For example, draw a monster with three eyes and write 'los ojos'.



Extension challenge: Can you write a short sentence in Spanish describing a body part using colours? For example: 'Mis ojos son marrones' (My eyes are brown). Use a dictionary to find a colour if you need to!
