2. 2. When you nod to agree, you are moving this: _____. (1 mark)

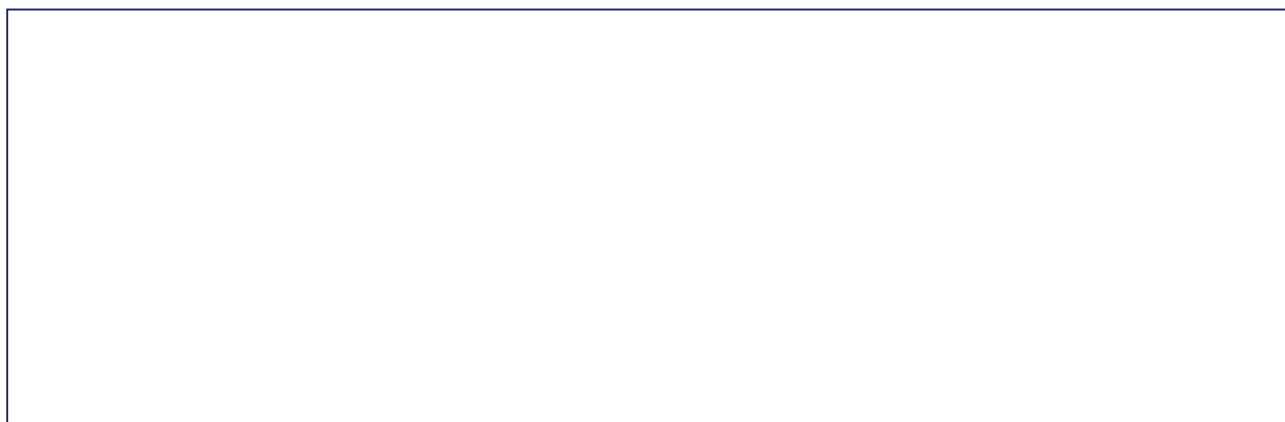
3. 3. You use these to clap when you are happy: _____. (1 mark)
