

Rosa's Spanish Body Parts Fact-File

Learning objective: To identify and write the names of body parts in Spanish, correctly using masculine and feminine articles (el/la).

Help Rosa the parrot learn about human anatomy! Use the word bank to label the body parts in the fact-file boxes below. Remember to include the correct article (el for masculine, la for feminine) for each body part. Write a short sentence in Spanish describing one feature of the body part you have chosen.

Word bank: la cabeza (head) · los ojos (eyes) · la nariz (nose) · la boca (mouth) · los brazos (arms) · las manos (hands) · las piernas (legs) · los pies (feet)

1. Body Part 1: Choose a part of the head. Write the Spanish name with its article and a sentence describing it (e.g., 'La boca es roja'). (2 marks)

2. Body Part 2: Choose a part of the arm or hand. Write the Spanish name with its article and a sentence describing it (e.g., 'Las manos son pequeñas'). (2 marks)

3. Body Part 3: Choose a part of the leg or foot. Write the Spanish name with its article and a sentence describing it. (2 marks)

4. Challenge: If you had to describe your own body in Spanish, which three parts would you mention? Write them below using the correct articles. (3 marks)

5. Reflection: Why is it important to use 'el' or 'la' before the noun in Spanish? Explain your reasoning. (2 marks)

Extension challenge: Choose a partner and play 'Simón dice' (Simon says). Use your new vocabulary to give instructions, such as 'Simón dice: toca la nariz' (Simon says: touch the nose).
