

Spanish Assessment: ¿Qué llevas puesto? (What are you wearing?)

Learning objective: To identify, describe, and categorise clothing items in Spanish while applying correct gender and number agreement.

Read each question carefully. Use the word bank provided to help you with spelling. Ensure your answers match the gender (masculine/feminine) and number (singular/plural) of the items.

Rosa the parrot is getting ready for a nature walk with her friends. She looks at her wardrobe and says: 'Hoy llevo una camiseta roja y unos pantalones azules. ¡Hace frío, así que necesito un abrigo blanco también!'

Word bank: la camiseta (t-shirt) · los pantalones (trousers) · el jersey (jumper) · la falda (skirt) · los zapatos (shoes) · el vestido (dress) · el abrigo (coat) · las botas (boots) · llevo (I am wearing) · rojo/a (red) · azul (blue) · blanco/a (white) · negro/a (black)

1. Based on the passage, list two items of clothing Rosa is wearing in Spanish. (2 marks)

2. Translate the following sentence into Spanish: 'I am wearing a black skirt.' (2 marks)

3. Explain why we use 'unos' instead of 'un' for 'pantalones' (trousers). (3 marks)

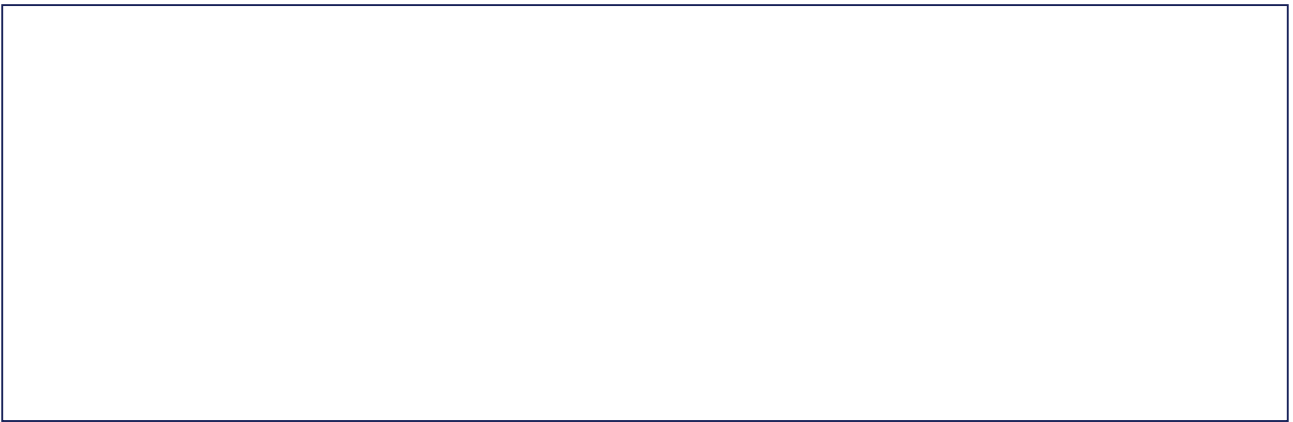
4. If a friend is wearing a blue dress and white boots, how would you write that in Spanish? Remember to check your noun-adjective agreement. (3 marks)

5. Rosa is packing for a trip. Write a short paragraph in Spanish (3-4 sentences) describing what she is wearing and what she is packing for the cold weather. Include colours. (5 marks)

6. Match the clothing item to its gender: (a) el jersey, (b) la falda, (c) los zapatos. Are they masculine or feminine? (3 marks)

7. Max the monkey wants to buy new shoes that cost £25. If he has £30, how much change does he get? Write the price of the shoes (£25) in Spanish words. (7 marks)

Draw: Draw Rosa the parrot wearing an outfit of your choice. Label at least three items of clothing in Spanish using your best handwriting.
