

Rosa's Weekly Diary: Los Días de la Semana

Learning objective: To recall and sequence the days of the week in Spanish and understand their order.

Rosa the parrot has been keeping a busy diary of her travels, but her notes have got all muddled up! Help her organise her week. Below is a list of Rosa's activities. Write the correct Spanish day of the week next to each activity based on the sequence provided in the clues. Remember: in Spanish, the days of the week are not written with a capital letter unless they start a sentence.

Word bank: lunes · martes · miércoles · jueves · viernes · sábado · domingo

1. 1. Rosa starts her week by reading poetry with Leo. Which day is this (the first day of the school week)? (1 mark)

2. 2. On the second day, Rosa practises her flying. Write the Spanish word for Tuesday. (1 mark)

3. 3. On the third day, Rosa helps Nova look at the stars. Which day is this? (1 mark)

4. 4. Rosa spends the fourth day counting £1 coins with Max. Write the Spanish word for Thursday. (1 mark)

5. 5. On the fifth day, Rosa teaches Spanish songs to her friends. Which day is this? (1 mark)

6. 6. On the sixth day, Rosa visits the park with Zara. Write the Spanish word for Saturday. (1 mark)

7. 7. On the final day of the week, Rosa rests in her nest. Write the Spanish word for Sunday. (1 mark)

Draw: Draw a picture of Rosa the parrot doing her favourite activity on a 'viernes' (Friday). Add a speech bubble of her saying '¡Hola!' to her friends.



Extension challenge: Write a short sentence in Spanish about what you like to do on a 'sábado' or 'domingo'. For example: 'El sábado, yo juego en el parque.'
