

Rosa's Spanish Café: Food and Drink

Learning objective: To identify and use vocabulary related to food and drink in Spanish, and to express preferences using 'me gusta' and 'no me gusta'.

Help Rosa the parrot prepare for her Spanish café! Use the word bank to answer the questions and demonstrate your understanding of healthy eating and preferences in Spanish.

Word bank: la manzana (apple) · el plátano (banana) · el pan (bread) · el queso (cheese) · la leche (milk) · el agua (water) · el pollo (chicken) · me gusta (I like) · no me gusta (I do not like)

1. Rosa wants to make a fruit salad. Which two items from the word bank should she choose? Write them in Spanish. (2 marks)

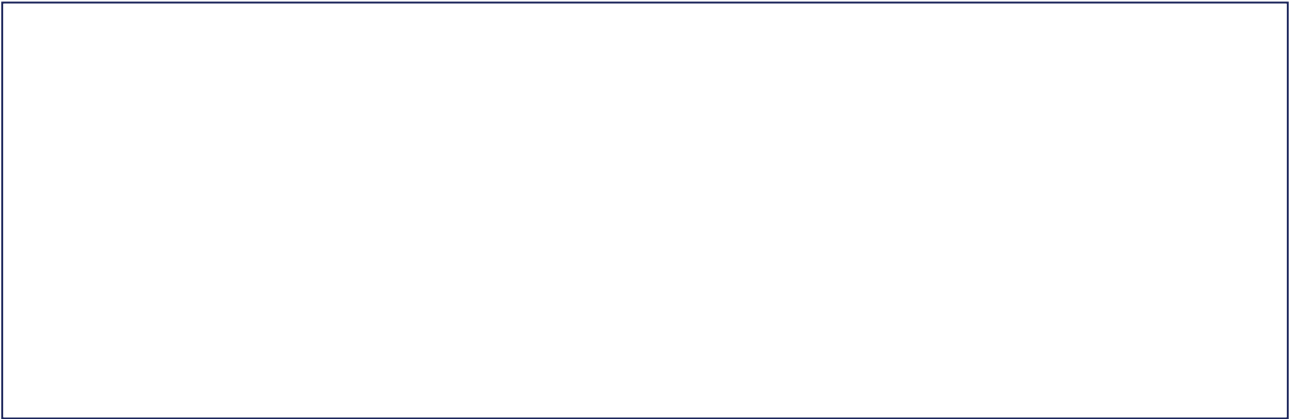
2. Translate the following sentence into English: 'Me gusta el queso y el pan.' (2 marks)

3. If you were choosing a healthy drink from the list, which one would you pick? Write your answer in Spanish: 'Me gusta...' (2 marks)

4. Write a sentence in Spanish saying that you do not like chicken. Use the word bank to help you. (2 marks)

5. Rosa is very thirsty. Which word from the list represents the drink she needs? Write the Spanish word. (1 mark)

Draw: Draw a plate of food containing three items from the word bank. Label each item in Spanish.



Extension challenge: Research one other Spanish food item not in the word bank (e.g., 'la paella' or 'la naranja') and write a sentence explaining whether you would like to try it or not using 'Me gusta' or 'No me gusta'.
