

Rosa's Calendar of the Year

Learning objective: To learn and recall the twelve months of the year in Spanish and represent them visually.

Rosa the parrot has brought us a special calendar project! Follow the steps below to illustrate your own Spanish calendar. Use the word bank to label your drawings correctly.

Draw: Create a 12-square grid layout on your paper. In a colourful, artistic style, illustrate a scene in each square that represents a specific month of the year. For example, draw a colourful umbrella for 'abril' or a bright sun for 'julio'. Ensure each square is clearly labelled with the correct term from the word bank in neat, legible handwriting.



Label words: enero · febrero · marzo · abril · mayo · junio · julio · agosto · septiembre · octubre · noviembre · diciembre

Steps:

1. Step 1: Divide your page into twelve equal boxes. In each box, draw a small picture that reminds you of that month (e.g., a snowman for January, a flower for May). Label each box with the correct Spanish month from the word bank.
2. Step 2: Which Spanish month sounds most similar to its English name? Write your answer here.
3. Step 3: Write the Spanish word for the month your birthday falls in.
4. Step 4: Look at your drawings. Which month did you choose to represent with a sunshine symbol, and

what is its Spanish name?

5. Step 5: Write the Spanish word for the month that comes immediately after 'marzo'.
