

¡Los Meses del Año! With Rosa the Parrot

¡Hola! Join Rosa the Parrot on a flight through the calendar. Can you master the Spanish months?

■ The year begins with 'enero'. What is the name of the final month in the Spanish calendar?

■ Spanish months follow the same order as English. How many months are there in total?

■ Look at the list: 'marzo', 'abril', 'mayo'. These are the three months of spring. Can you spot which one is May?

■ Rosa says: 'Mi cumpleaños es en agosto.' This means her birthday is in August. Can you identify which month comes immediately after agosto?

■ Identify the pattern: Why do you think 'septiembre', 'octubre', 'noviembre', and 'diciembre' sound so similar to the English words for 7, 8, 9, and 10?

Did you know? Did you know? In Spanish, the months of the year are not written with a capital letter unless they start a sentence! Also, the names are very similar to English because both languages share roots from the ancient Latin language.
