Learning objective: To recall and spell the twelve months of the year in Spanish and understand their sequence.

Join Rosa the parrot on a linguistic adventure! Use your knowledge of Spanish months to complete this quiz. Read each question carefully and choose the correct answer or provide the requested information.

Answer Key: 1.C, 2.A, 3.B, 4.True, 5.False, 6.enero, 7.diciembre, 8.agosto, 9.septiembre, 10.junio. Note: In Spanish, months are not capitalised unless they begin a sentence.

9. Which month is 'septiembre'? (1 mark)

10. What is the Spanish word for June? (1 mark)

Extension challenge: Greater Depth Challenge: 1. Explain why it is important to remember that Spanish months do not use capital letters. 2. Compare the spelling of 'septiembre' and 'diciembre' to their English equivalents; what similarities and differences do you notice? 3. Justify why learning the months is a foundational skill for communicating about birthdays or school timetables. 4. What might happen if you mixed up the order of the months in a sentence? 5. If a Spanish friend invited you to a party in 'julio', how would you know when to go? 6. Research and explain why the Spanish calendar months have similar roots to the English ones.
