

Rosa's Seasonal Spanish Calendar

Learning objective: To recall and correctly spell the twelve months of the year in Spanish and sequence them chronologically.

Rosa the parrot has been flying around the world and has accidentally mixed up her travel diary pages. Look at the jumbled Spanish months below. Use the word bank to help you sequence them correctly from January to December in the spaces provided. Once you have ordered them, complete the challenge questions to show your understanding of Spanish time vocabulary.

Word bank: enero · febrero · marzo · abril · mayo · junio · julio · agosto · septiembre · octubre · noviembre · diciembre

1. Write the correct Spanish month for the first four months of the year (January, February, March, April) in the correct order. (4 marks)

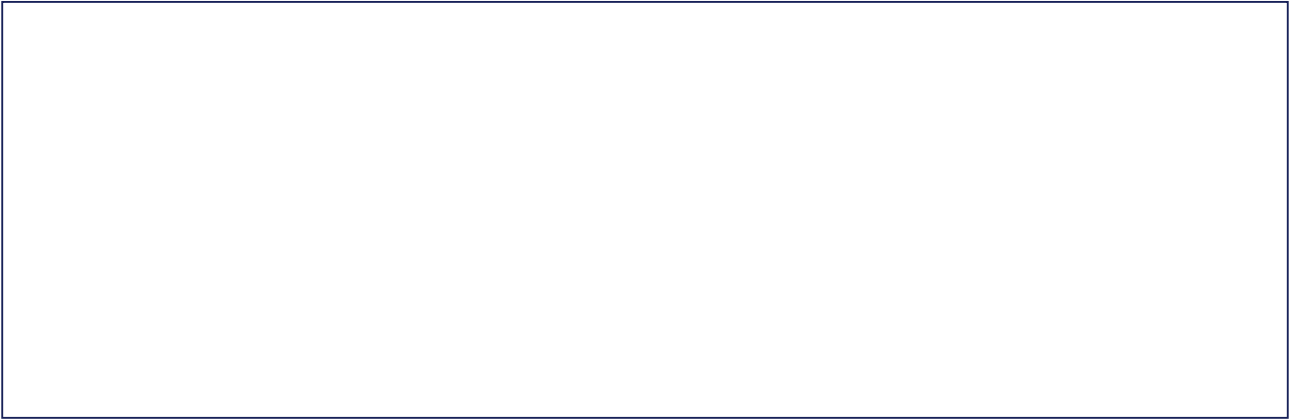
2. If Rosa visits a beach in 'agosto', which English month is she visiting? (1 mark)

3. Look at the word 'diciembre'. Can you identify which English month it represents and explain why they look similar? (2 marks)

4. Translate this sentence into English: 'Mi cumpleaños es en mayo.' (1 mark)

5. Fill in the blank: 'Junio, _____, agosto.' (Write the missing month in Spanish). (1 mark)

Draw: Draw a large circle representing a clock face. Instead of numbers, divide it into twelve segments and write the Spanish months in the correct order around the circle. Decorate each segment with a small symbol representing the weather or a special event typical for that month (e.g., a snowflake for 'enero' or a sun for 'julio').



Extension challenge: Research how to say the four seasons in Spanish (primavera, verano, otoño, invierno) and group your twelve months under the correct season header.
