

Rosa's Spanish Calendar Diary

Learning objective: To learn and recall the twelve months of the year in Spanish and apply them to personal dates.

Join Rosa the parrot on a journey through the year! Use this template to record when your favourite events happen. First, study the word bank to learn the Spanish names for each month. Then, fill in the diary entries below by writing the month in Spanish, the date, and the event name.

Word bank: enero (January) · febrero (February) · marzo (March) · abril (April) · mayo (May) · junio (June) · julio (July) · agosto (August) · septiembre (September) · octubre (October) · noviembre (November) · diciembre (December)

1. Birthday Celebration: Write the month of your birthday in Spanish and the specific date. What do you usually do to celebrate? (2 marks)

2. Summer Holiday: Write the month in Spanish when you usually go on your summer break. Where would you like to travel to? (2 marks)

3. Favourite Season: Choose a month in Spanish that belongs to your favourite season. Why do you enjoy this time of year? (3 marks)

4. School Events: Which month in Spanish does your school hold its sports day or annual concert? Describe the event. (3 marks)

5. Pattern Recognition: Look at the months. Which three months in Spanish sound most similar to their English names? Explain why. (4 marks)

Extension challenge: Try to write a full sentence in Spanish for each entry, such as 'Mi cumpleaños es en...' (My birthday is in...).
