

Rosa's Spanish Opinion Workshop

Learning objective: To be able to express and justify opinions about hobbies using Spanish phrases.

Help Rosa the parrot learn to share her thoughts! Use the word bank to help you complete the sentences and answer the questions. Remember to use 'porque' (because) to add a reason.

Rosa is visiting a school in Spain. She wants to tell her new friends what she thinks about different activities. She uses: 'Me gusta/encanta/no me gusta' + [activity] + 'porque' + [reason].

Word bank: Me gusta (I like) · No me gusta (I do not like) · Me encanta (I love) · porque (because) · es divertido (it is fun) · es aburrido (it is boring) · es emocionante (it is exciting)

1. Rosa loves football because it is exciting. Write this sentence in Spanish using the word bank. (2 marks)

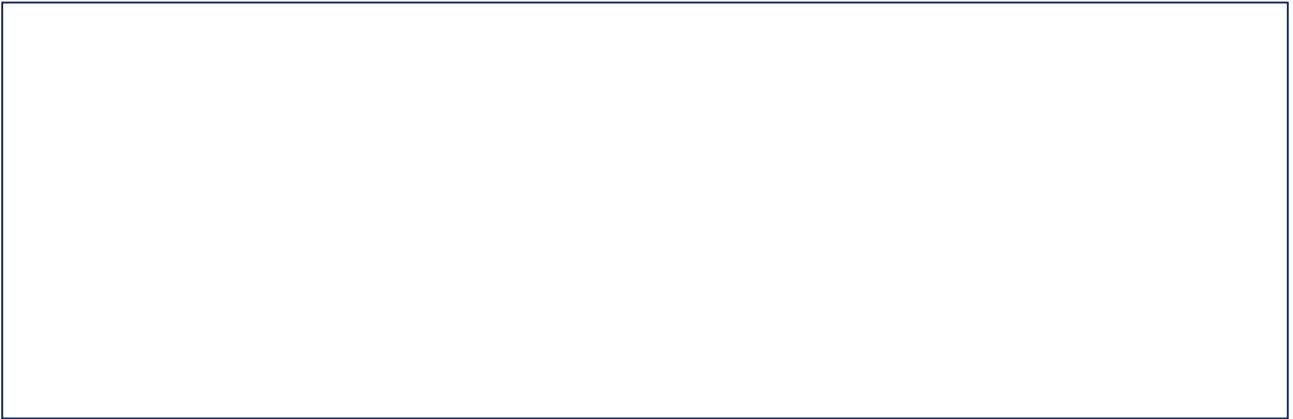
2. If you do not like reading, how would you write that in Spanish? Start your sentence with 'No me gusta'. (2 marks)

3. Translate this sentence into English: 'Me encanta la música porque es divertida.' (2 marks)

4. Choose one hobby (e.g., swimming, drawing, dancing). Write a full Spanish sentence expressing your opinion and a reason why. (3 marks)

5. Why do we use the word 'porque' in a sentence? Explain its purpose in your own words. (2 marks)

Draw: Draw a picture of yourself doing your favourite hobby. Above the picture, write a speech bubble for yourself in Spanish that says: 'Me encanta [hobby] porque es divertido!'



Extension challenge: Can you find a partner and ask them: '¿Te gusta el fútbol?' (Do you like football?). Record their answer in Spanish using 'Sí, me gusta' or 'No, no me gusta'.
