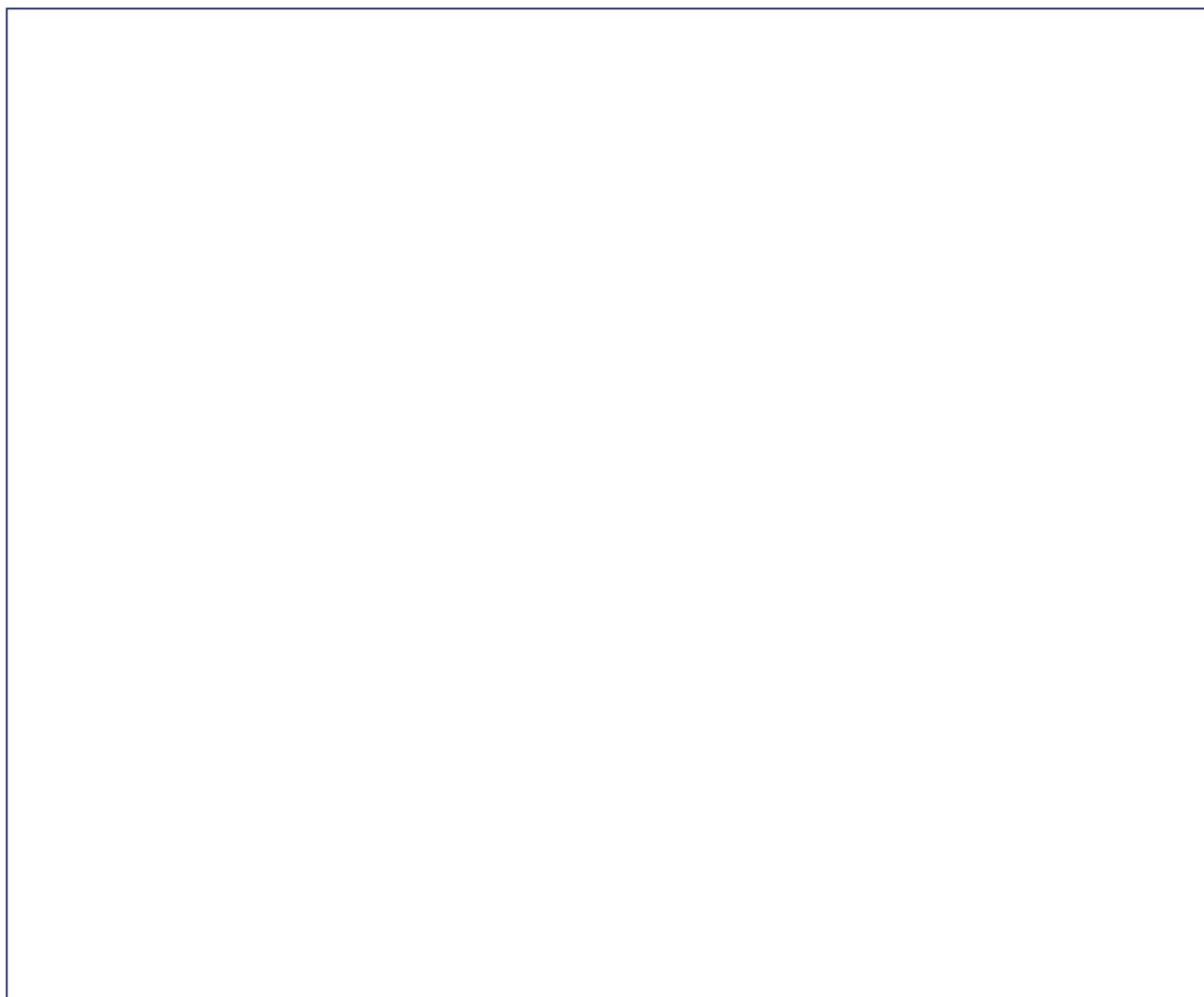


Rosa's Spanish Opinion Garden

Learning objective: To use Spanish phrases to express opinions about hobbies and interests.

Help Rosa the parrot design her favourite garden! Read the opinion phrases in the word bank and draw items to represent your own hobbies. Add speech bubbles to your drawings to show how you feel about them using the Spanish phrases provided.

Draw: Draw a large, colourful garden scene. In the centre, draw Rosa the parrot holding a sign. Around her, draw four different sections of the garden representing hobbies (e.g., a football, a book, a musical note, and a paintbrush). Use speech bubbles coming from the hobbies or from characters in the garden to include the opinion phrases from the word bank. Use a bright, cheerful art style.



Label words: Me gusta... (I like...) · No me gusta... (I do not like...) · Me encanta... (I love...) · Odio (To hate - use 'Odio...') · El fútbol · La música · La lectura · El arte

Steps:

1. Write a sentence in Spanish using 'Me encanta' to describe an activity you love doing in the park.
2. Write a sentence in Spanish using 'No me gusta' to describe a hobby you are not fond of.
3. If you wanted to say 'I like art', how would you write that in Spanish?
4. Rosa says 'Me encanta la lectura'. What does this mean in English?

5. Choose one item from your drawing and write a full sentence in Spanish explaining your opinion of it.
