

Mi Vida Escolar: A School Fact-File with Rosa the Parrot

Learning objective: To use Spanish vocabulary to describe school subjects, opinions, and daily routines in line with the Class 5 curriculum.

Help Rosa the parrot organise her school records! Use the Spanish vocabulary bank to complete this fact-file about your own school life. For each section, write your answer in Spanish, and include a short English translation where requested to show your understanding.

Word bank: las matemáticas (maths) · el inglés (English) · la educación física (PE) · el arte (art) · la ciencia (science) · me gusta (I like) · no me gusta (I do not like) · es interesante (it is interesting) · es aburrido (it is boring) · mi profesor/a es simpático/a (my teacher is nice)

1. Mis Asignaturas (My Subjects): List three subjects you study at school using the word bank. Which one is your favourite? (3 marks)

2. Mis Opiniones (My Opinions): Write two sentences about your school subjects using 'me gusta' or 'no me gusta' and give a reason why. (4 marks)

3. El Profesorado (The Teachers): Describe your favourite teacher in Spanish using the word bank. Is your teacher 'simpático' or 'simpática'? (2 marks)

4. La Comida (Lunch): What do you eat for lunch? Write the name of one food item in Spanish and say if it is 'delicioso' (delicious). (2 marks)

5. Resumen (Summary): Translate your favourite sentence from this fact-file into English to show Rosa exactly what you have written. (2 marks)

Extension challenge: Imagine you are showing a new student around your school. Write three more Spanish sentences describing where things are, such as 'La biblioteca está aquí' (The library is here).
