

Un día de compras con Rosa

Learning objective: To read and understand a short text in Spanish about shopping, identifying key vocabulary and prices.

Read the passage about Rosa's trip to the market. Use the word bank to help you understand the text and then answer the questions below in English.

¡Hola! Soy Rosa. Hoy voy al mercado con mis amigos. El mercado es muy grande y colorido. Primero, vamos a la frutería. Quiero comprar manzanas rojas para mi merienda. Las manzanas cuestan £2. ¡Es un precio muy barato! Después, visitamos la tienda de ropa. Veo una camiseta azul muy bonita, pero cuesta £15. Pienso que es un poco cara, así que decido no comprarla hoy. Finalmente, vamos a la panadería porque tengo mucha hambre. Compró un pan delicioso por £1.50. Me encanta ir de compras porque puedo practicar mi español y elegir cosas ricas para comer. ¡El mercado es mi lugar favorito para pasar el sábado con mis amigos!

1. What two items did Rosa decide to buy at the market, and how much did they cost in total? (2 marks)

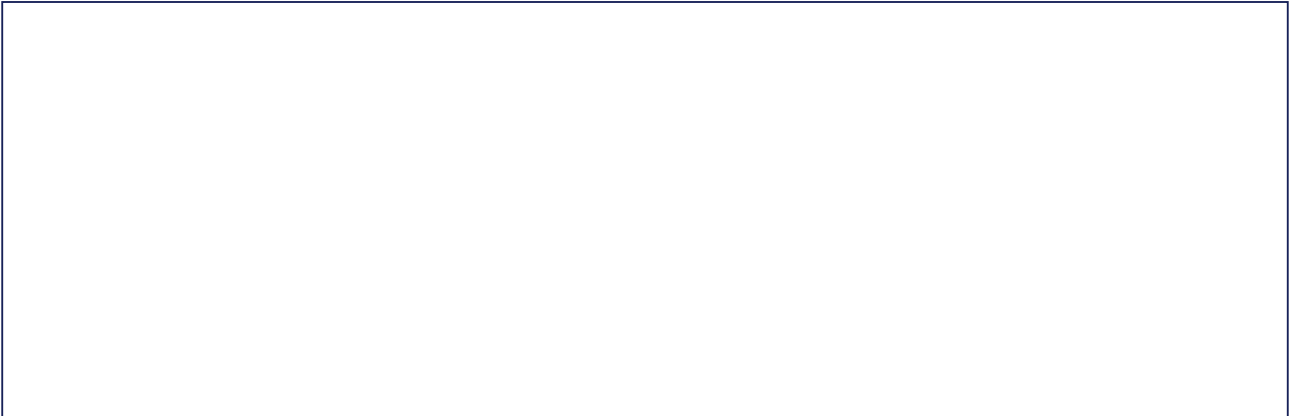
2. Why did Rosa choose not to buy the blue t-shirt? (2 marks)

3. Based on the text, how does Rosa feel about the market environment? (2 marks)

4. Why do you think Rosa specifically mentions that the market is a good place to practise her Spanish? (2 marks)

5. Do you think £15 for a t-shirt is expensive? Explain your reasoning using the context of the passage. (2 marks)

Draw: Draw a scene at the market showing Rosa the parrot looking at a basket of red apples and a blue t-shirt, with price tags clearly labelled in pounds.



Extension challenge: Imagine you are at the market. Write three sentences in Spanish describing what you would buy and how much it costs, using the phrase 'Yo compro...' and 'Cuesta...'
