

¡Vamos de Compras! (Let's go shopping!)

Join Rosa the parrot on a shopping adventure! Practise these phrases to become a confident Spanish shopper.

- When you want to know the price of an item, you ask: '¿Cuánto cuesta?'
- If an item is a great bargain, you can describe it as 'barato'.
- If an item costs too much, you can describe it as 'caro'.
- To say 'I want to buy', you say 'Quiero comprar'.
- Remember: always be polite! Say 'Por favor' (please) and 'Gracias' (thank you).

Did you know? Did you know? In Spain, the official currency is the Euro (€), but when we talk about shopping in the UK, we use Pounds (£). If you were in a Spanish market, you might hear a shopkeeper say 'Son cinco euros', which means 'It is five euros'!
