

Rosa's Spanish Market Adventure

Learning objective: To use Spanish vocabulary for shopping, prices, and food items in the context of a market visit.

Imagine you are visiting a bustling market in Spain with Rosa the parrot. Use your Spanish vocabulary to plan your shopping trip. Fill in the boxes below to describe what you are buying, how much it costs in pounds, and your polite conversation with the stallholder.

1. My Shopping List: List three items you want to buy at the market. Write the Spanish word for each item. (3 marks)

2. The Price Tag: Choose one item from your list. Write the price in pounds (£) and describe if it is cheap or expensive using Spanish phrases. (3 marks)

3. The Conversation: Write a short dialogue between you and the shopkeeper. Use '¿Cuánto cuesta?' to ask for the price and 'Gracias' to finish the transaction. (4 marks)

4. Reflecting on Learning: Why is it important to use polite phrases like 'Por favor' and 'Gracias' when shopping in another country? (2 marks)

5. Currency Comparison: If you have £10.00 to spend, how many items costing £2.00 could you buy? Show your maths working out. (3 marks)

Extension challenge: Create a colourful sign for your favourite market stall. Include the name of your stall, three items for sale, and their prices in £.
