

Rosa's Sports Day Drawing Challenge

Learning objective: To identify and use Spanish vocabulary for common sports and physical activities.

Help Rosa the parrot prepare for a Spanish sports festival! Follow the drawing steps below, label your items using the Spanish word bank, and complete the sentences to show what you know.

Draw: Create a vibrant sports scene on an A4 sheet of paper. In the centre, draw Rosa the parrot holding a whistle. Around her, draw four different zones for sports: a grass pitch for football, a blue pool area for swimming, a court with a hoop for basketball, and a track for athletics. Use bright colours and clear lines. Ensure you label each activity clearly in Spanish as requested in the questions.



Label words: el fútbol (football) · el tenis (tennis) · el baloncesto (basketball) · la natación (swimming) · el atletismo (athletics)

Steps:

1. Draw a football pitch on the left side of your page. Label the ball using the correct Spanish term from the word bank.
2. Draw Rosa the parrot wearing a swimming cap. Label this activity using the correct Spanish term.
3. Draw a basketball hoop in the corner. Write the Spanish word for basketball next to it.
4. If you wanted to say 'I like football' in Spanish, you would say 'Me gusta el fútbol'. Write a sentence to say

which sport is your favourite using 'Me gusta...'.

5. Imagine you are buying a new tennis racket for £12.50. If you pay with a £20 note, how much change should you receive?
