

Rosa's Transport Adventure

Learning objective: To learn and identify Spanish vocabulary for different modes of transport.

Help Rosa the parrot map out her journey! Use the word bank to label the vehicles in your drawing. Make sure your labels are written in Spanish.

Draw: Draw a busy travel scene. Include a winding road with a car (el coche) and a bicycle (la bicicleta), a train track with a train (el tren), a harbour with a boat (el barco) on the water, and a bright blue sky with an aeroplane (el avión) and a bus (el autobús) driving along a street. Make the scene colourful and clear so each vehicle can be easily labelled.



Label words: el coche (car) · el autobús (bus) · el tren (train) · el avión (aeroplane) · el barco (boat) · la bicicleta (bicycle)

Steps:

1. Label the vehicle that travels on tracks using the correct Spanish word from the word bank.
2. Label the vehicle that flies in the sky.
3. Which Spanish word would you use to describe a vehicle with two wheels that you pedal?
4. Draw a small flag on your 'barco' and write the Spanish word for it underneath.
5. Look at your drawing. If you were travelling across the sea to visit a new country, which transport from your list would you choose? Write your answer in Spanish.
