

Rosa's Spanish Transport Adventure

Learning objective: To learn and apply Spanish vocabulary for different modes of transport and express how one travels using the phrase 'Voy en...'

Rosa the parrot is getting ready for a trip! Read the Spanish word bank carefully, then answer the questions below to help her plan her journey. Remember to use 'Voy en' (I go by) for your answers.

Word bank: el coche (car) · el autobús (bus) · el tren (train) · la bicicleta (bicycle) · el avión (aeroplane) · el barco (boat) · el metro (underground/tube)

1. Rosa wants to travel to Spain quickly. Which mode of transport from the word bank should she use? Write the answer in Spanish. (1 mark)

2. If you are travelling through London to school, which transport do you use? Complete this sentence: 'Voy en...' (1 mark)

3. Max the monkey wants to go to the park for exercise. Which mode of transport from the list is the best for exercise? Write the name in Spanish. (1 mark)

4. Translate the following sentence into English: 'Voy en tren a la estación.' (2 marks)

5. Imagine you are going on a holiday across the sea to an island. Which word from the list would you use? Write a full sentence starting with 'Voy en...' (2 marks)

Draw: Draw a picture of yourself travelling on your favourite mode of transport. Label your drawing using the correct Spanish word from the word bank.

Extension challenge: Rosa is planning a trip to a city with a famous underground system. Research why 'el metro' is a popular way to travel in big cities and write one sentence in English explaining its benefit.
