

Rosa's Weather Report: El Tiempo

Learning objective: To use Spanish vocabulary to describe different weather conditions and create a daily forecast.

Rosa the parrot has been travelling across Spain! Use this template to help her write a weather report for different cities. Use the word bank to fill in the sections and describe what the weather is like in each location.

Word bank: Hace sol (It is sunny) · Hace calor (It is hot) · Hace frío (It is cold) · Llueve (It is raining) · Hace viento (It is windy) · Está nublado (It is cloudy) · La temperatura es... · En [City Name]...

1. The Morning Report: Choose a city in Spain and describe the weather using a full Spanish sentence. (2 marks)

2. Temperature Check: Write down the temperature for your chosen city and explain if you would need a coat or sunglasses. (2 marks)

3. Activity Planning: Based on the weather you chose, write one activity you could do in that city (e.g., 'Voy a la playa' or 'Leo un libro'). (2 marks)

4. The Afternoon Change: Describe how the weather has changed by the afternoon using a different weather phrase from the word bank. (2 marks)

5. Rosa's Summary: Write a final sentence explaining what the weather is like across the whole country today. (2 marks)

Extension challenge: Research a second Spanish city and write a comparison sentence using 'pero' (but) to show how the weather is different between the two locations.
