Worked example:

Look at the sound 'wh'. Trace the word: wh-a-t

Answer: what

- **Trace these 'wh' words:**

when why whip whisk

- **Complete the words by adding 'wh' at the start:**

___en ___at ___y ___ip

- **Read what Pip the caterpillar is asking:**

Why is it hot? When is lunch? What is that?

- **Circle the words that start with 'wh':**

when, dog, whip, why, cat, what

- **Choose a word from the list above and write it in a sentence:**

when what why

Self-check: Check your spelling against the list at the top to make sure every 'wh' word starts with both letters.
