

Sheet 8: Reading Between the Lines

Worked example:

Read the sentence: 'Pip put on his sun hat and walked to the beach.' Which season is it? (Summer/Winter)

Answer: Summer, because Pip needs a sun hat and is going to the beach.

- Read the sentence: 'Nova saw the colourful leaves falling from the trees.' Which season is it?
- Read the sentence: 'Max saw tiny buds appearing on the branches and heard birds singing.' Which season is it?
- Read the sentence: 'Ellie saw the grass covered in frost and her breath made a white mist.' Which season is it?
- Read the sentence: 'Finn felt the hot sun and decided to splash in the cool water.' Which season is it?
- Read the sentence: 'Zara wore her thickest scarf and woolly gloves to go outside.' Which season is it?

Self-check: Check your answers: Did you use the clues like 'frost', 'buds', or 'sun' to pick the right season?
