1. What are the main colours you chose? Why did you pick them? (2 marks)

2. Are your lines sharp and zig-zagged, or soft and curvy? Why? (2 marks)

3. What feeling or emotion does your piece of art show? (2 marks)

4. If your art had a name, what would it be? (1 mark)

Extension challenge: Try to make a second piece of art using only shapes that have four sides, like squares and rectangles. How does that change the feeling of the work?
