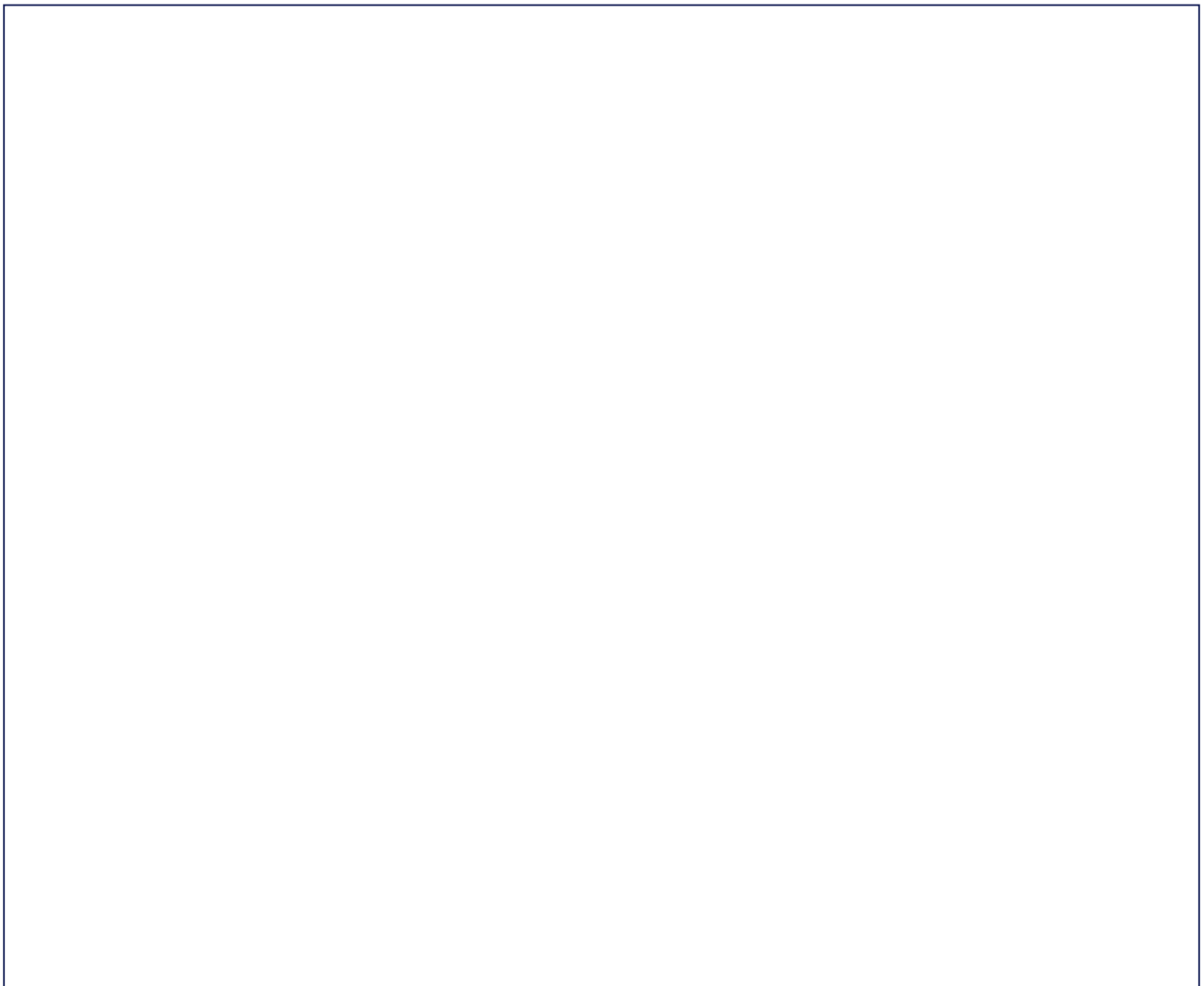


Autumn Art with Zara the Zebra

Learning objective: To use observational skills to draw and label autumn patterns and colours.

Follow these steps to create your autumn picture. Zara the Zebra loves to spot patterns in nature. Look at the word bank to help you label your drawing.

Draw: Draw an autumn scene on your paper. In the middle, draw a large leaf. Add lines on the leaf to show the veins. Draw two acorns on the ground next to the leaf. Colour your picture using warm autumn colours like red, orange, and yellow. Try to make a repeating pattern on the edges of the leaf.



Label words: acorn · leaf · veins · stalk · pattern · autumn

Steps:

1. Step 1: Draw a large leaf in the centre of your paper. Make it look like it has just fallen from a tree.
2. Step 2: Draw the veins on your leaf. Use a pencil to make small, thin lines that spread out from the middle.
3. Step 3: Draw two small acorns sitting next to your leaf. Remember to draw the little cups on top.
4. Step 4: Label your leaf and your acorns using the words from the word bank.
