Grab your pencils and paints! Let's capture the magic of autumn.

- Autumn colours are often called 'warm' colours. These include shades of red, orange, yellow, and brown.
- You can find beautiful patterns in nature. Look at the veins on a leaf to see how they branch out like a map.
- Texture is how something feels. You can use a crayon rubbing on tree bark to show rough textures in your art.
- Symmetry means both sides are the same. Many leaves have a line down the middle with the same shape on each side.
- Zara the zebra loves to mix colours. Try painting with a mix of yellow and red to make your very own sunset orange.

Did you know? Did you know? As the days get shorter, trees stop making green chlorophyll. This allows the hidden yellows, oranges, and reds in the leaves to finally show themselves!
